This year, a total of 100 applications were received. The committee examined each applicant's letter and found all of them to be exceptional students: we were happy to see the academic achievements from the children of our colleagues. We granted the Local 38 Heritage Scholarship to 79 recipients after the committee adjudicated the applications.

While we had expanded the eligibility criteria for the Heritage Scholarship to include students who are enrolled in vocational or transitional programs, no students applied. Please encourage your colleagues to remind their child to apply if they are enrolled in vocational or transitional programs.

Looking ahead

In Winter 2025, we will also look into adjusting the amount per scholarship for 2025 as tuition and living expenses have Increased since the last time the amounts were adjusted. If necessary, we will submit our budget assumptions to the Treasurer in 2025 to reflect the higher amount.
