

Leadership Quality Standard

Your ATA Professional Development Committee is providing a half day session to help you understand and familiarize yourself with the Leadership Quality Standards (LQS).

As previously communicated by the Deputy Minister on 2018 08 24, recent amendments to the *School Act* require all Alberta principals and superintendents in public, separate, francophone, charter and private school authorities to hold appropriate leadership certification, effective 2019 09 01. If you are an aspiring leader or is currently in a leadership role, this workshop will help you further understand the LQS.
