Achievements

This year, a total of 102 applications were received, plus one duplicate. This is an unusually high number of applicants this year. As usual, we were impressed by the academic achievements from the children of our colleagues. We are pleased to grant the Local 38 Heritage Scholarship to 75 recipients after the committee adjudicated the applications. Three additional scholarships were awarded by Table Officers as part of the appeals process.

We expanded the eligibility criteria for the Heritage Scholarship to include students who are enrolled in vocational or transitional programs.

Looking ahead

My recommendation to next year's Scholarship Committee is to ensure more clear and open communication with executive members, especially after a significant change in leadership positions.
